



20 Hours SAFE Comprehensive: Financing Residential Real Estate

GRADING and PASS/FAIL CRITERIA

Assessments

Periodic quizzes may be administered by the Instructor. The quizzes are used for student self evaluation; therefore, they are not graded. Students will be administered a final examination consisting of 100 multiple choice questions. The examination is a multiple-choice style timed examination in which students will be given 150 minutes to complete. The minimum passing score is 80%. Students who fail the examination may retake throughout the duration of their course.

Completion Timeline

Upon registering, students must complete the course and all final exams before the course expiration date. If taking an Internet-based course, the student's password will be deactivated after the course expiration date has passed. If an extension is required, additional fees will be assessed.

Course Credit

To receive credit and a certificate of completion, a student must complete the entire course of study, including a final exit examination. Partial credit cannot be given for any course. As a student progresses through a course, periodic brief quizzes will be administered.

The credit hours of instruction awarded for each course are those allocated by the respective regulatory agency or state Commission. Typically, the amount of credit is based on the amount of time an average student would take to complete the program. In general, a credit hour is based on a 50 minute clock hour.
